Panel Mount Antenna

This image shows the complete components of the Panel Mount Antenna.

The whip screws onto the hinge, which is tightened onto the base using an Allen key. Below this base there is a rubber seal, to stop water leaking through. On the underside of the steel is a spindle with a base, onto which the outer base is secured.

The coaxial cable runs out of the lower base, and if fitted to the inside of a narrowboat or similar should be run in conduit or trunking, in as short a run as possible. If possible drill the required 12mm dia hole above a light fitting to allow access at a later date if needed.

The cable has an FME connector at the opposite end to the antenna. It is important that this connector is not cut; as it is essential for mating the adapter to the mobile phone. If this is removed we will not offer a replacement connector.

Test for continuity before sealing in conduit or behind a lining.
